Dr N. Igmar:

The roots of degeneracy in society are undoubtedly connected to Jewish influence. The Jews often use the poison of liberalism along with other forms of societal decay that weaken societal and economic powers at be. Because of the Jews extremely ethnocentric, nepotistic, desire for power, and for thirst for destruction (typically of the white race, def. Loxism), they have been at the epicenter and root of most degeneracy in society controlling institutions such as the media, banks, government, industries, etc. While this essay is not soley targeted at the Jews role in the destruction of society, I believe it is important to acknowledge the root of degeneracy if we are to weed it out.

We must root it out at the source lest it comes back to plague us again.

Feminism is by far one of the worst, and also typically first, form of degeneracy that has historically lead to collapse of societies. Giving women any rights over men and or equal to men will always result in a catastrophic long-term failure hurting society overall as a result of weak men.

When women are given the right to vote, they choose to vote for bigger government. But why is this? Women will vote for bigger government typically because they base their decisions often in emotions and thus often vote for politicians that give them a sense of security. Big Brother is actually just the woman's ideal society because women don't want freedom, they want to feel safe. This has to do also with women having less brain matter than their male counter-parts. But one thing is clear: women are not equal to men and biologically never will be. So to give them equal vote and rights to men is just as much absurd as saying men and women are biologically equal. Also, interestingly, women are more inclined to parasitic actions than men, such as lying, denoted by more prefrontal white matter than men on average. Children are also prone to lying to get what they want; however, just like in the women's case, neither are justified on the surface and both should be punished accordingly.

However, feminism puts women on a pedastal, untouchable by any men, lest they face society's wrath for "hurting a poor woman's feelings". Putting women on this pedastal divides men and women on a societal level turning them against each other and away from traditional relationships being in a pressured state of conflict. It's unnatural for women to be equal to men: it destroys the sense of a traditional relationship where a man provides for a woman, and the woman provides for the man's kids. Nowadays under feminism, both men and women are expected to work making both sexes unhappy with their conditions as neither of them feel as fulfilled as they would in a traditional relationship.

All this has done is further weaken the nuclear family and women's power in society in general being forced to compete with men when they did not have to.

Seneca the Sage:

Discipline and temperance come through introspection and through societal pressures. These limiters of sinful behavior have been removed through various groups who advocate for sinful behavior. Though the advocates of these movements vary, and their goals are numerous, the names of these demons' ideologies are as follows: Marxism, LGBTQ+, apathy, sexual liberation, feminism, contemporary

This is applied to schooling, where there is the idea of 'no student left behind'. This program, adopted through various means by many nations, has lowered the <u>quality of education</u>, lowered academic performance, and raised the students discontent with the education they receive. The class will slow itself down to cater to the slowest of the students. Advanced classes cannot make up for this loss, as the brilliance of some students surpass the content delivered there. Even then, some others will fail to come into those classes as they are tainted with the bad behavior of the others in the class.

Equity is simply a more intense version of equality. To stay in line with the former example, this is akin to students having resources taken away from their education in order to supplement the deficiencies of the slower students. Affirmative action does exactly that, giving quotas to demographics who are inferior to the average/other groups. This way the game will continue to be "fair". In no means is equaling out the playing field a fair or just action, though what is and what is not just is a discussion of its own.

Let us not forget the cry for the dissolution of government, which comes from the idea that the masses can govern themselves. Naturally, there are steps to arrive here, which is first to create a massive government. In many instances this can be ignored by those who practice Marxist ideals, as they will wish to skip to the idea of anarchism. Still, they all inhibit the same ideas: The destruction of the government through one means or another. The government may be destroyed by growing it, as this expands the deficit, decreases the public's trust in the government, and diversifies its interests.
